We have hired a replacement for Jen Gage. His name is David Lee. He has been with us for about three weeks now and is doing very very well.

The ArtsWestchester Grant performance was this past weekend. It was well attended and seemed to be enjoyed by all.

We will be closing the library on June 8th for mandatory staff AED/CPR and Narcan training.

The roof contract for Ed Corey has been signed and sent back to him with the 1/3 deposit. He will begin ordering materials and will let me know when we can schedule. Most likely we will be closed for three days while the work is completed, as the only safe access point for his workers is from the front of our building. The noise level is also highly likely to be disruptive to operations anyway.

LVD is ordering parts and will fix our doors next week assuming parts come in on time.

The LCD panel for our sound system is leaking the LCD fluid. The panel still works, but the leak has gotten progressively worse. It is unclear if the panel will still work once all the fluids drains out. To replace it, it appears that it will be rather pricey (5k to 8k range) so it probably is not worth doing unless the panel fully stops working. At this point the equipment is about 10 years old, but overall it still functions well, if not a bit complicated in operation.
